The adoration of the *Plaschenytsia* has been a practice among the Slavic people for a very long time. In the days of ole, the faithful of the parish kept vigil round the clock from the end of Vespers on Great Friday until Easter Sunday morning at Matins. The population size now determines the length of veneration of the shroud. It has been a long practice in our parish to have a few hours on Friday and on Saturday. During this time in front of the *Plaschenytsia*, one has the time to think about all that Jesus has done for us, and what we have received from Him in return. It is a time to pray and reflect on our life as a Christian, and to let Jesus speak to us. It is an awesome hour to just sit quietly, and listen for Jesus. We are given the opportunity through our traditions to sit with our Lord. This is also a gift to give to our children: time to sit in front of Jesus, and time to see that we value our Lord so much that we will sit in His presence, and show them how much we love God. If you did not sign up, more hours can be added to the list.

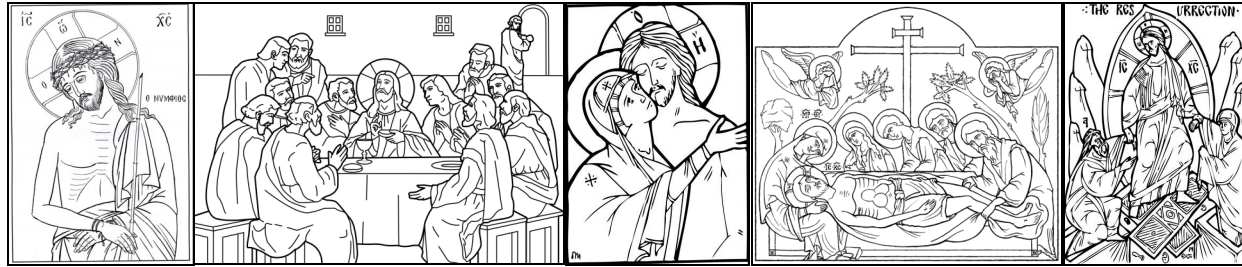
