Structure of the Catechism - from *Christ Our Pascha*

This Catechism is composed of three parts: "The Faith of the Church," "The Prayer of the Church," and "The Life of the Church." This division reflects the very essence of Christian salvation. In the prayer of the Anaphora, while remembering all the events of salvation history the crown being the Passover of Christ - the Church professes the fundamental truths of the Christian faith. These truths, along with the explanation of the Symbol of Faith, are presented in part one of the catechism.
