

- from Christ Our Pascha

Part Two of the Catechism develops the liturgical understanding of Christ's Passover, based upon the words of Christ's institution of the Eucharist at the Mystical Supper [Last Supper] and as cited by the Anaphora. This is the Eucharistic heart from which proceed all the cycles of the Church's liturgical prayer (daily, weekly, yearly); from which flow the Holy Mysteries on their celebration; and from which spiritual life is born, and devotion flourishes.
