

The Feast of the Protection commemorates the appearance of the most holy Theotokos in the Church of Blachernae in Constantinople as recorded in the life of Saint Andrew the Fool for Christ's sake. While the multitudes of the faithful were gathered in church, Epiphanius, the friend of Saint Andrew, through the Saint's prayers, beheld the Virgin Mary the Theotokos approached the center of the church, knelt down and remained in prayer for a long time. Her face was drowned in tears.

Then she took her veil (Mantle) off and spread it over the people as a sign of protection. During the time, the people in the city were threatened by a barbarian invasion. After the appearance of the Mother of God, the danger was averted and the city was spared from bloodshed and suffering.

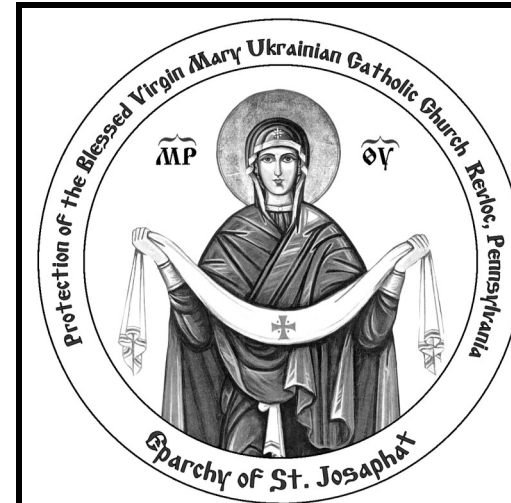
