#### **Good Friday Services**

Vespers begin as the church is dimmed. The Psalms and the Litanies are chanted. At Tranquil Light, the lights of the church are turned on. The Gospel is read telling of the passion and crucifixion. This is when the odes are sung or recited. Near the end of Vespers, a procession is formed. The faithful process around the exterior of the church carrying the Plaschenytsia as those who buried Jesus taking Him to the tomb. When the faithful reenter the church, the Plaschenytsia is placed on a table representing the tomb. The faithful of old would keep a vigil until sunrise on Easter.

#### **Pascha Services**

Shortly before sunrise, the faithful arrive with their Easter baskets. They enter the darkened church and venerate the Plaschenytsia until services begin. After the faithful sing the Noble Joseph, the Plachentysia is placed on the Holy Table. The priest returns to the nave and a procession begins and proceeds around the exterior of the church. The people sing and all the bells ring out that Christ is Risen! As the faithful come to the doors of the church to reenter, they are closed. The faithful sing Christ is Risen to petitions of the priest. Once they are finished the priest takes the hand cross and seals the doors with the sign of the cross and bangs on the doors. The doors are opened and the faithful walk into the church fully lit singing Christ is Risen! Resurrection Matins begin followed by the Divine Liturgy. After Liturgy, the priest will bless the Easter baskets on the steps of the Altar.


