Adoration of the Holy Shroud

The central focus of Good Friday services is the Plaschanytsia (Holy Shroud). The Holy Shroud speaks to us of the severe justices of God and His everlasting love and unfathomable mercy toward us sinners. The Holy Shroud is the winding sheet in which Christ's dead body was wrapped when it was laid in the tomb. During Great Friday Vespers, a procession is made around the church with the shroud. After the procession, the shroud is placed on a specially prepared table in the middle of the church. At the end of Vespers, the Noble Joseph is sung three times and all approach the shroud on their knees and kiss the hands, feet and side of our Lord. The grave is adorned with candles and flowers, and behind the grave is a cross draped with a cloth. The Holy Shroud remains exposed for veneration until Resurrection Matins. Among our people the Holy Shroud is truly venerated and loved and is only approached on your knees. By the grave of our Lord, an honor guard stands provided by the faithful. This is for the faithful, a truly profound spiritual experience and an opportunity to renew our faith and love for Christ, who out of love for us, died on the cross. Come and adore the Holy Shroud. Next Sunday, there will be a sign-up sheet for you to spend time with Him.


