Ephesians 6:10-17

Luke 13:10-17

*Troparion (Tone 2)*

When You went down to death, O Life Immortal, You struck Hades dead with the blazing light of Your divinity. When You raised the dead from the nether world, all the powers of heaven cried out: “O Giver of life, Christ our God, glory be to You!”

*Troparion of Feast*

Today is the prelude of the good pleasure of God, and the proclamation of salvation for the human race. In the Temple of God the Virgin is clearly revealed, and beforehand announces Christ to all. To her, then, let us cry aloud with a mighty voice: Rejoice, fulfillment of the Creator’s plan.

*Kondakion*

Glory be...

You arose from the tomb, O Almighty Savior; and Hades, seeing this wonder, was stricken with fear; and the dead arose. Creation saw and rejoices with You, and Adam exults.

And the world, my Savior, sings Your praises for ever.

*Kondakion of Feast*

Now and forever ...

The Savior’s pure temple, the precious bridal chamber and Virgin, the sacred treasury of the glory of God, is brought today into the house of the Lord; and with her she brings the grace of the divine Spirit. God’s angels sing on praise of her: She is indeed the heavenly swelling place.

*Prokeimenon*

(Tone 3) My soul magnifies the Lord, and spirit has rejoiced in God, my Savior.

*Verse:* Because He has regarded the humility of His handmaid; for behole, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed.

(Tone 2) The Lord is my strength and my song of praise, and He has become my salvation.
