

## ST JOSAPHAT, BISHOP AND MARTYR

St Josaphat was born in Ukraine about 1580, ordained about 1604; he became a Basilian monk. He was a noted theologian and preacher, and loyal to Rome. He was made bishop of Polotsk in 1617, and embarked on a thorough-going pastoral reform, visiting his clergy, seeing that the people were instructed and taking an interest in the liturgy. His reforms aroused hostility, and he was murdered at Vitebsk, during a pastoral visit, on November 12, 1623
