

Candles

- Behind the altar table there is usually a seven-branched candle stand which comes from the Old Testament tradition of the Jewish temple. Generally speaking, the Jerusalem temple is highly valued in the Eastern Christian tradition of worship and church construction as a “prototype” of the true worship “in spirit and truth” of the Kingdom of God (John 4.23).
- A single candle is hung near the Holy Place. The Sanctuary Light is to let the faithful and visitors know that the Real Presence is reserved in the tabernacle.
- Lighting candles is an important part of Eastern worship. We light them as we pray, making an offering to accompany our prayers. Candle typically lit when coming into the Church.
