### **Candles**

- Behind the altar table there
- is usually a seven-branched candle stand which comes from the Old Testament tradition of the Jewish temple. Generally speaking, the Jerusalem temple is highly valued in the Eastern Christian
- tradition of worship and church construction as a "prototype" of the true worship "in spirit and truth" of the Kingdom of God (John 4.23).
- A single candle is hung near the Holy Place. The Sanctuary Light is to let the faithful and visitors know that the Real Presence is reserved in the tabernacle.
- Lighting candles is an important part of Eastern worship. We light them as we pray, making an offering to accompany our prayers. Candle typically lit when coming into the Church.


