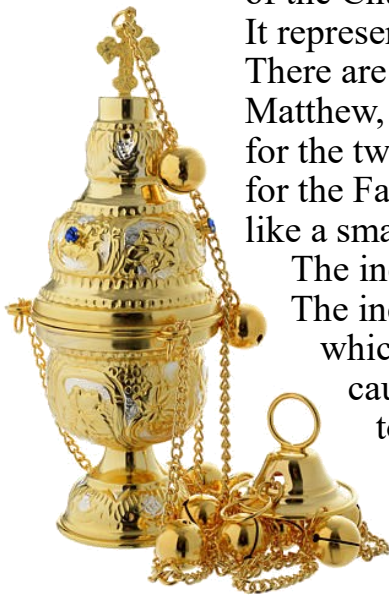


Know Your Church . . . Laity Formation

Incenser

The Censer of the Eastern Church has a very special meaning. The censer has a mounted ring at the top representing God the Head of the Church. Next is a ring attached to the middle chain. It represents Christ coming down from heaven to save us. There are 4 chains to symbolize the four evangelists: Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. The twelve bells are for the twelve Apostles. The three outer chains are for the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The censer is shaped like a small church with a cross on the top of the dome. The incense that is burned is our prayers rising to heaven. The incense is small nuggets put on a hot charcoal which smoke as they burn. The swinging of the censer causes the air to bellow the charcoal to burn and not smolder the incense.
