The Meaning of the Wedding Ceremony in Our Church

The rushnyk The rushnyk, an embroidered towel, interlaced with threads of various colors, represents all aspects of human life: family, love, tradition, hardship and faith in God. The couple stands on the rushnyk to indicate the new life they now begin. Whoever stands on the rushnyk first will be the “boss” of the house.

Bestowal of Rings The rings are the symbol of betrothal and their exchange signifies that in married life the weaknesses of the one partner will be compensated for by the strength of the other, the imperfections of one by the perfections of the other. By themselves, they are incomplete: together they are made perfect. Thus the exchange of rings gives expression to the fact that the spouses in marriage will constantly complement each other.

The Crowning Crowns of flowers or metal are placed on the heads of the bride and groom to signify the dawn of a new kingdom to be ruled by the couple—side by side. They also remind the newlyweds that their marriage is a partnership in Christ, and that they owe it to God and to each other to live a life of honor and love.

The Candles The candles symbolize the spiritual willingness of the couple to receive Christ, Who will bless them through this Mystery.

Troparion (Tone 7)

By Your cross You destroyed death; You opened Paradise to the thief; You changed the lamentation of the myrrh-bearers to joy, and charged the apostles to proclaim that You are risen, O Christ our God, offering great mercy to the world.

Troparion of Feast

Today is the prelude of the good pleasure of God, and the proclamation of salvation for the human race. In the Temple of God the Virgin is clearly revealed, and beforehand announces Christ to all. To her, then, let us cry aloud with a mighty voice: Rejoice, fulfillment of the Creator’s plan.

Kondakion

Glory be... No longer shall the dominion of death be able to hold humanity, for Christ went down shattering and destroying its powers. Hades is bound. The prophets exult with one voice. The Savior has come for those with faith, saying: “Come forth, O faithful, to the resurrection!”

Kondakion of Feast

Now and forever ... The Savior’s pure temple, the precious bridal chamber and Virgin, the sacred treasury of the glory of God, is brought today into the house of the Lord; and with her she brings the grace of the divine Spirit. God’s angels sing on praise of her: She is indeed the heavenly swelling place.

Prokeimenon

(Tone 3)My soul magnifies the Lord, and spirit has rejoiced in God , my Savior. Verse: Because He has regarded the humility of His handmaid; for behold, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed. (Tone 2)The Lord is my strength and my song of praise, and He has become my salvation.

Alleluia

Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia The rich among the people shall entreat your countenance. Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia Lord, grant victory to the king, and hear us in the day that we shall call upon You. Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia
