You have been given a gift from the third Person in the Trinity. Embrace it and worship God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. We are preparing for our eternal salvation. We need to want to be with God and to worship Him with all of our being. This is preparation for what is to come. We have all gone to school. We are learning about God, we are putting into practice what we have learned and need to do to prepare for the test. Remember there is only one final. The test prep is up to you.


