

Know Your Church . . . Laity Formation

Is it Theophany or Epiphany?  
Let's take a look at the parts of each word.  
Theo-phany: Theo - means God and phany - means to appear or to show.  
When translated means: God-appears.  
Epi-phany: Epi - means forth and phany - means to appear or to show.  
When translated means: show-forth.  
Now that the words have been explained now let's look at the two words as used by the Church. Theophany means a visible manifestation to humankind of God or God revealing Himself to us. Epiphany means a visible manifestation to humankind of a divine being or the Divine revealing Himself to us. The terms mean the same thing. The term Epiphany has come to the tradition of the three kings arriving to give their gifts to the Christ child. The term Theophany has come to the tradition of Christ being baptized in the Jordan.  
Hopefully, you will now have an epiphany of the words Theophany and Epiphany.

Resurrection Troparion (Tone 6)
