

Know Your Church . . . Laity Formation

Our Church helps us to prepare for the Great Fast with the 5 pre-Lenten Gospels with Zacchaeus Sunday, the Sunday of the Publican and the Pharisee, the Prodigal Son, the Sunday of the Last Judgment, and Forgiveness Sunday. Each week helps us to self-reflect about our life and the direction it is going. Zacchaeus Sunday lets us look at how the things that we do in life can keep us from Jesus, but He will search you out to come to your house. The Publican and the Pharisee lets us look at how we view others and how Jesus wants us to truly not judge but ask for forgiveness. The Sunday of the Prodigal Son is for us to know that we can return to Jesus if we come to Him and ask forgiveness for straying away. The Sunday of the Last Judgment reflects on the words of Jesus and what the final judgment will be like. We need to amend our lives to be sheep instead of goats. And finally, Forgiveness Sunday. Forgiveness Sunday is the last to help us self-reflect on our changes before we begin the Great Fast. Forgiveness Sunday is for us to forgive everyone and anyone who has wronged us and to ask forgiveness of those we have wronged. Take this time and truly review your life. If you were to take your last breath tonight, would you be ready to receive the forgiveness from Jesus for the wrongs you have done in your life. Remember the line, “Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us.” This line is a double-edged sword. We are telling God not to forgive us if we are not willing to forgive others. These are truly awesome weeks to help us prepare for the changes we need to make throughout the Great Lent.
