Why do some of the hymns during the Liturgy change during Lent?
During the Great Lent the Anaphora changes in the Liturgy. This is where the Liturgy of St. Basil and St. John Chrysostom differ. St. Basil wrote longer silent prayers for the priest to pray therefore making a need to have the music in that part of the liturgy change. The Liturgy of St. Basil is celebrated on the Sundays of the Great Fast, Christmas Eve, Theophany Eve, and on January the 1st, the feast of St. Basil.

**** Remember it is our tradition to bless pussy willows of Palm Sunday. Please check with friends and family if they have pussy willow trees. The trees here at the church are not producing many pussy willows this year. ****

Hebrews 4:14-5:6 Mark 8:34-9:1

Troparion (Tone 7)
By Your cross You destroyed death; You opened Paradise to the thief; You changed the lamentation of the myrrh-bearers to joy, and charged the apostles to proclaim that You are risen, O Christ our God, offering great mercy to the world.

Troparion of the Cross (Tone 1)
Save Your people, O Lord, and bless Your inheritance. Grant victory to Your faithful people against enemies, and protect Your community by Your cross.

Kondakion (Tone 7)

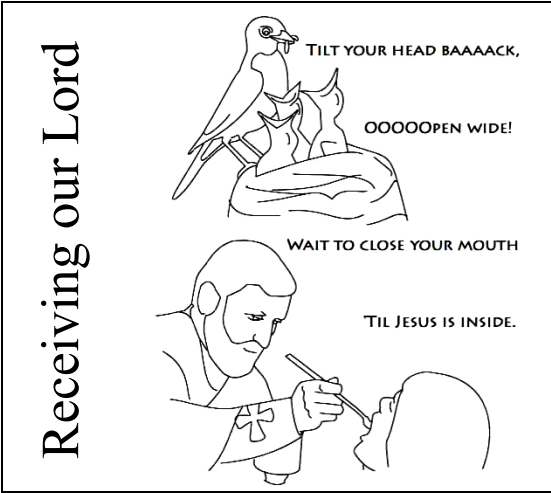
