Colors of the Seasons

Our Ukrainian Catholic Church has set colors for the different seasons of the Church Year. The Church groups the colors as dark vestments and bright vestments. Solemn times calls for dark vestments and festive times call for bright vestments.

Dark Colors

Red is used for martyrs, funerals, and for the days honoring the Holy Cross. Red/Purple may also be used during the Great Fast and Philip's Fast

Bright Colors

White is used for Easter Gold is used for Christmas White and Gold are also worn throughout the year.

Blue is used the Mother of God Green is only used for the week of Pentecost
