Who were the Myrrh Bearers?

At least eight women are known to have come to the tomb to anoint the body of Jesus. They are Mary Magdalene; Mary, the Theotokos; Joanna; Salome; Mary, the wife of Cleopas; Susanna; and Mary and Martha of Bethany. Five of these women were rich: Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Susanna, and Jesus dear friends, Mary and Martha. Three of these women were at the foot of the cross as Jesus was being crucified. They are Mary Magdalene, Jesus' mother, and Salome. During Jesus' ministry, these eight women had been together a lot. Some of them helped to fund His ministry. When these women arrived at the tomb, they found the stone rolled away, and were instructed to bring the joyful news to the Apostles that Jesus had risen. Why myrrh for a dead body? Myrrh, for one, has the fragrance to overtake the odor of decay. Secondly, Myrrh dries things out, so it absorbs the moisture from the body and preserves it from corruption. When the women arrived, the stone was still across the entrance of the tomb, but, as they were talking about how to remove the stone, an angel rolled the stone away. When the women looked, they saw the angel sitting on the stone, and entered the tomb, and the angel appeared with them there as well. He told them not to be afraid, and that "the Crucified" had risen. They were then instructed by the angel to go tell the disciples that Jesus was risen.
