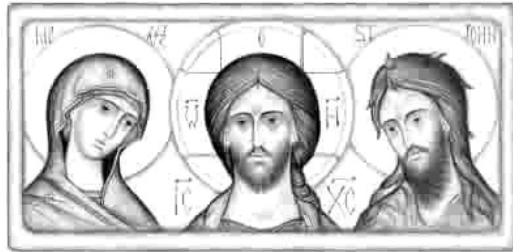


Know Your Church . . . Laity Formation
