In the Eastern Christian Churches, we remember when the Mother of God appeared in the Church of Blachernae in the year 911. The city was under attack and the faithful gathered in the church to pray for protection. It is said that while the people were praying, the doors of the church opened and the Mother of God along with St. John the Baptist and St. John the Beloved walked down the main aisle and Mary went to the holy table and knelt and prayed. When she was finished she walked out the doors of the church. The faithful followed her but she was gone. She appeared in the sky holding her mantle over the city. The attackers lost the battle and the city was saved by her Holy Protection. Her protecting veil shone "more than the rays of the sun." The Mother of God prayed to her Son to accept the prayers of all the people who call on His Name, and to respond quickly to her intercession,

"O Heavenly King, accept all those who pray to You and call on my name for help.

Do not let them go away from my icon unheard."


