

DID YOU KNOW?

Byzantine Rite Catholics make the Sign of the Cross differently than Roman Catholics do.

With your right hand...

The last two fingers remain flat against the palm, representing the two natures of Christ: Human and Divine.

The thumb and first two fingers come together to a point, representing the Holy Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER... Touch your right hand to your forehead.

...AND OF THE SON... Touch your right hand to your lower chest or belly.

...AND OF THE HOLY SPIRIT... Touch your right hand first to your right shoulder, and then to your left shoulder.
