Our life goes by; death's sickle draws nearer, and the dread judgment and retribution await us. God is the one true and just judge, Who has no need of witnesses, accusers or evidence. 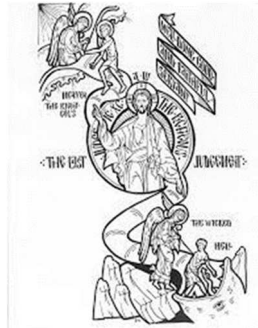
