## 2nd Ecumenical Council

The second ecumenical council was held in Constantinople in 381 under Emperor Theodosius the Great. 150 Bishops were present. The council was held to refute the Macedonian controversy. Macedonius, somewhat like Arius, was misinterpreting Church's teaching on the Holy Spirit. He taught that the Holy Spirit was not a person ("hypostasis"), but simply a power ("dynamic") of God. Therefore the Spirit was inferior to the Father and the Son. The Council condemned Macedonius' teaching and defined the doctrine of the Holy Trinity. The Council decreed that there was one God in three persons ("hypostases"): Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The holy fathers of the Council added five articles to the Creed. They read as follows:

"I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the Giver of Life, who proceeds from the Father: who with the Father and the Son is worshiped and glorified: who spoke by the prophets. I believe in One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church. I acknowledge one baptism for the remission of sins. I look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen."
