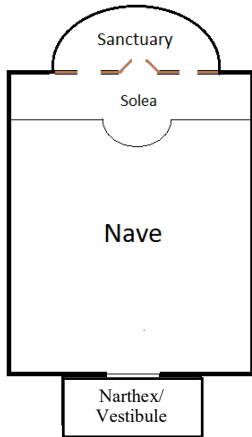

The ambo/solea

The space before the iconostasis is called the ambo or solea, and may extend out in a semicircle into the nave; the priest or deacon reads the Gospel from the ambo/solea, facing the people, and the deacon stands on the ambo/solea, facing the sanctuary, to lead the petitions of the congregation to God. The ambo from which the Gospel is proclaimed and preached has its origins in the earliest days of the Church, as a sign of the open tomb of Christ from which the deacon would proclaim the Good News of salvation and new life. The ambo of today represents the open grave of Jesus on Easter

morning. The deacon fills the role of the angel who proclaimed the resurrection when he proclaims the Gospel from the ambo. The last public prayer of the Divine Liturgy is the "Prayer Before the Ambo", originally a prayer of thanksgiving said as the clergy descended the ambo at the end of the service.
