Elements of the Liturgy

Canons
 Later, the short hymns or troparia which were sung in alternation with the Scriptural canticles at Matins developed into an elaborate poetic form, called a Canon. Even though most of the canticles are no longer sung outside of the Great Fast, canons remain an important part of Matins, and are also sung at certain other services. Each canon consists of up to nine "odes", with the last ode always dedicated to the Mother of God. The refrain and first verse of this ode (called "magnification" and "irmos") are sung at the Divine Liturgy on feast days.
