Taste

Bread, of course, is the common foodstuff of the Mediterranean world, and like water represents the basic necessities of life - though Jesus told his disciples that it is not sufficient: "Man does not live by bread alone." He chose bread and wine as symbols of his body and blood, to be sacrificed to save us, and gave us a memorial (the Eucharist) in which offerings of bread and wine become his Body and Blood, to be given to us. In our liturgy, bread is also blessed on major feasts (with a prayer that God will multiply it throughout the world) and distributed at festal vigils to sustain the faithful during nights of prayer.

Wine, a drink like water but far richer, represents the choice blessings God has in store for his people; its ability to bring joy and even inebriation symbolize the life in which we are caught up in gladness in the Holy Spirit. By ancient tradition, the faithful fast from wine and other alcoholic drinks during periods of penance or preparation, and then wine is blessed on the eves of feasts and distributed to the faithful. And of course, like bread, it is used in the sacrificial meal of the Eucharist, where it is mixed with a small amount of water to represent the union of God's divine nature with our human nature.

Troparion (Tone 2)

Troparion of the Feast (Tone 4)

Today is the prelude of the good pleasure of God, and the proclamation of salvation for the human race. In the Temple of God the Virgin is clearly revealed, and beforehand announces Christ to all. To her, then, let us cry aloud with a mighty voice: Rejoice, fulfillment of the Creator's plan.
