In the Ukrainian Catholic Church there are twelve major feasts. From the twelve, the Bishops have selected six to be more special. It is our custom to attend church on all Sundays and Holy Days. In the Roman Catholic Church they have made many adaptations to the rule. Currently there are six Holy Days of Obligation, This custom is foreign to our Church, even though some priests/parishes have adopted this "Obligation Day" custom.


Pashca or Easter is not included in the list because it is the Feast of Feasts.
